2024 Application Requirements



North Central Electrical League awards \$1,500 scholarships to dependent children of NCEL members. NCEL works vigorously to help get you started in the electrical industry and give back to our members. Please review eligibility, application requirements and the application form.

NCEL'S SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM IS OFFERED TO NCEL MEMBERS' KIDS TO:

- Promote our electrical industry;
- Promote NCEL membership benefits;
- Provide a valuable financial benefit directly to our NCEL members; and
- Encourage advanced education career paths to those meeting scholarship criteria.

Since 1994, NCEL has awarded \$639,000 in scholarships to children of NCEL Members.

Current Year High School Graduates must meet ALL of the following:

1. Be accepted/enrolled in an accredited college, university, or tech school, and provide a copy of the Letter of Acceptance from respective school.
2. Submit your most recent high school transcript.
3. Provide a 300 word essay on one of the electrical topics below.
Online essays must be in MLA style and formatted in PDF to be accepted.
4. Complete Scholarship Application Form.

Current Year Undergraduates must meet ALL of the following:

1. Be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate student (at least 12 credits/term).
2. Submit a copy of your most recent college/university/tech school transcript.
3. Provide a 300 word essay on one of the electrical topics below.
Online essays must be in MLA style and formatted in PDF to be accepted.
4. Complete Scholarship Application Form.

Essay Requirement: ALL applicants must submit a 300-word essay that captures one of the following electrical industry topics:

1. "If you were in charge of marketing this industry, how would you make the electrical industry more well known?"
2. "Where do you think our industry will be in the next 5 years?"



**Application Deadline:
April 30, 2024**

Submitting Your Application: Include all required documentation in one package to the NCEL office via postal mail, fax, online, or email before the deadline. Submit before the deadline to NCEL at the address listed below.

One Application Per Student: No limit on the number of applicants per family. Previous applicants and recipients may reapply. Graduate students are not eligible. Parents must currently work at an NCEL member company within MN, SD, ND, or Western WI.

Selection Opportunities: Winner(s) will be selected via random drawing of qualified applicants to eliminate any bias. The random scholarship drawing will take place in June or July. All applicants will be notified of the results shortly after the drawing. Winners will be announced on our website and in our newsletter. Scholarship checks are made payable to the school, in the winners' name, and mailed to the permanent company address of the member parent as indicated on this application form. Winners will be mailed checks before the end of August.

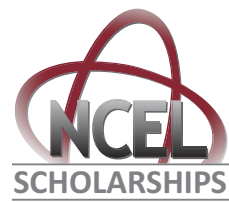

- Copy of tech school, college, or university Letter of Acceptance (if high school student).
- Essay of 300-words on one of the electrical industry topic questions listed on reverse side.

Essay must be in MLA style and formatted in PDF to be accepted.
